There were several computer driven errors in the last FY2006 CSBG allocation chart and we have redone the calculations based on what we know as correct and the result is that we have a new allocation chart that we are confident is correct. We very much appreciate those of you who have brought this to our attention. Most importantly, you should know that the new allocations are clearly based on a proportional reduction using the most accurate figures.

This means that you will know from looking at the attached chart, the exact amount that has been allocated to you so far, (col. 3); the accumulated amount you should receive in the third quarter (col. 4); and how much you will receive as third and fourth quarter awards (cols. 5 & 6).

I am confident that you will comprehend this newly devised allocation award process. We regret the confusion that any of our previous actions may have caused and hope that these allocations will assist you in planning the work that you must complete.
